

Everest Panorama Trek

Trip Overview

Everyone in this world must have heard of the tallest legendary Mt Everest. It lies in the Khumbu region which also known Everest region. In combination of the Sherpa Culture, their lifestyle one can enjoy the worlds popular mountain without hiking high and taking the risk of altitude sickness can catch the beautiful sight of the himalayas that stands sky-high in the Khumbu region.

A beautiful town called that hangs on the slope of Syangboche Airport at 3440m height both on the left and right with huge mountain Kongde and Kusum Kangaru also includes in the trip.

Foremost is the Everset View hotel that comes to be on the top of Syangboche with its altitude 3880m is the most fascinating point from the garden of this hotel, the Everest Panorama Trekkers can catch the mind-blowing picturesque view of the world's class himalayas like Kongde Ranges, Kusum Kangaru, Khumbila peak, Thamserku, Kantega, Amadablam, Lhotse, Nuptse, Everest including Twabuche and so on. Everest View that perched on the top of Syangboche is a peak it locates amid the himalayas narrates what are these world class himalayas. The view from this vantage point you will have, is not of the least but one and only panorama the trekkers of this package might have ever imagined.

Let's come and go crazy for this panorama view, we Aaozora Travel at Everest Trekking route package bring off.

Trekking Route Summary

Upon your arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport, representative of Aaozora Travel & Tour will receive you and assists to transfer hotel and further serves in hotel check-in service. Later trekking guide will brief team of Everest Panorama Trekking about the trekking and its route. Afterwards the briefing overs, free time, so the members will have exploration near the city it lives in.

Trekking journey be in commenced through a scenic thrilling flight from Kathmandu to Lukla. At landing at Lukla, the trekking starts to Phakding through the lush forest. Next day of team's stay at Phakding, trekking will be then heads to Namche Bazaar – the historical trade hub in everset region – along the Dudh Koshi. Crossing suspension bridge on top of Imja Khola

strenuous climbing trail continues to Namche Bazaar which will take about 3 hours from the suspension bridge we cross at the bottom of Syangboche hill.

At Namche team will have one more extra day schedule for having acclimatization; at this time the trekking group will remain no passive, rather hiking to Everest View Hotel through Syangboche airport. The most well-known world class mountain view vantage point, being wherein will be greeted by Khumbila peak, kwnagde, Thamserku, Kantega, Amadablam, Twauche, Nuptse, Lhotse, Everest and so on and also from the point the last destination of this Everest Panorama Trek 'Tengboche' can be seen clearly on the green hilltop at the shadow of Kantega. Now, on this day of acclimatization our activities overs and back to guest house to stay through Namche Museum.

Is This Trek Right For experiencing the Khumbu region?

A lot enough for those who like to catch the outstanding picturesque view of the mountain and the landscape that has been domain by Mt. Everest in short period of time including other who love to experience the himalayas which has attracted all the nature lover from the world with taking no risk of the altitude sickness.

The experience is not only limited to the mountains, the prevailing culture of sherpa, the animals, plants, and birds which has made their dwelling here in the high region. The trail is graded under as an easy to moderate the beginners with its normal physical condition can easily challenge for the taste of Khumbu Region well-known vies and vistas.

Best Season?

Going into the heart of world class well popular himalayan region is what known the Everest Panorama trekking in Khumbu Region and because paddling some strenuous steps on the steep climbing with dispense of hard earnings cashes the best season of the trekking route shall be confirmed. Mostly, September to November and March to may is known well to opt for trekking.

Announcement of the best season has been based on the reason that mostly these months, the skies are clear, temperature are tolerably mild, the beauty of the area is in the bloom. Autumn symbols the crisp of skies and it is crystal clear, the clouds on the himalayas are mostly high above, and the rhododendron forest at this high altitude the trekkers are to pass through are in full bloom.

Whereas in the spring, temperature is warmer, snows on the path are completely melted so easy to hike, and because it is just beginning after summer season the lush green are alive on the hills will surely reaches advantageous moment to the trekkers.

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu

Arrival to Tribhuvan International Airport Kathmandu and greeted by the airport representative of Aaozora Travel & Tour team of the Everest Panorama trekking will be transferred to hotel in

Kathmandu. Upon over of check in formalities, the team of trekking will brief about the trekking that is going to start from the next day.

Overnight at hotel in Kathmandu with breakfast inclusive.

Day 02: Fly to Lukla and trek to Phakding (2652m), 3 hours

Arrival at Lukla airport from Kathmandu on thrilling air drive, the team will then proceed to Phakding (2652m) about 150m low altitude than the Lukla; it becomes the sudden first step at this height and having no activities may unease the next day trekking. Hiking the easy and moderate way to Phakding through lush green valley will bring a reward of Kusum Kangaru peak.

Including breakfast, lunch, and dinner, overnight stay at guesthouse.

Day 03: Namche Bazaar (3440m) from Phakding, 6 hours

Wake up early in the morning, and having delicious breakfast at Phakding the trekkers will then heads to Namche Bazaar through the lush green trail along the Dudh koshi river. Gradually and steadily trekking goes towards Namche Bazaar through Monjo the gate to enter Everest National Park. Here the documents to go ahead to the Everest region all the trekking related documents like trekking permit, national park entry permit will be checked and inspected. Upon over of the formalities, the trekker will further heads to Namche Bazaar. The trail runs along the Dudh Koshi River, and it firstly comes to meet on the suspension bridge that hang on the top of Imja Khola and begins from here the strenuous trekking to Namche Bazaar for about 2.5 to 3 hours.

Inclusive of breakfast, lunch, and dinner, overnight stay at guesthouse in Namche Bazaar.

Day 04: Acclimatization and stay at Namche Bazaar

After taking breakfast at Namche hotel trekkers will then going uphill to make acclimatization activities which means gaining height and enjoying the great giant that stands welcoming the trekkers. Through Syangboche airport the trekkers pass and go to the top of the Syangboche hilltop where the Everest hotel locates with a beautiful garden that helps trekker to enjoy the amazing view of the himalayas that stand sky-high with sips of hot coffee, the most luxurious time it becomes in one's life.

The most amazing site it is, trekkers will have a beautiful view of Everest from here so has been the name of hotel is recognized as the "Everest View Hotel". Along with the world's top Mt. Everest, the glimpse on the neighbouring Lhotse, Nuptse is not of the least value. Upfront at eyeline trekkers will have whitely gleaming Twauche peak and Amadablam, whereas on the left, Kantega, Thamserku, Kusum Kangaru and on the right Khumbila peak with Kwangde from the back side surrounds the trekkers, amazingly the moment becomes very extraordinarily spiritual. With thanks to the one and only nature in the world, the trekkers now get down to the hotel through Namche Museum and take the rest. Do not sleep before the sleeping time which is not advisable in the mountain trip. Just fool around and enjoy the precious time with himalayas that stands from the inception to welcome you.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner included overnight stay at Namche bazaar.

Day 05: Trek to Tengboche (3860m/12660ft) Duration: 5 hours

The view of the Everest from Everest View hotel is somehow unfulfillment so we proceed to view closure from Tengboche the open hilltop at the bottom of Kantega, will bring you a

surprising view of the Everest, Lhotse, Nuptse, Amadablam, Twauche, and other like island peak, and Thamserku on the back side becomes more open with its real face.

Beginning from Namche bazaar about half an hour trail is strenuous which will then take you to a flatter wide trail on the lap of the Syangboche hill. Look at the right side up above the Imja Khola, there may be a helicopter flying to have some rescue activities, whether you notice, it flies about 100m down from the trail you are heading towards the Namche bazaar. You will have enough changes to have a site on Danphe (pheasants) the only bird that flies highest altitude on the world. As well you will have other himalayan birds view along with himalayan flora and fauna. Your trail, reaching at Kyangjuma splits into two – the right one that descends to Phungi Thanka that lies in the confluence of the river. Crossing the suspension bridge at Phungi Thanka, the trail begins ascending and it is steep climbs which will guide your way to Tengboche in two or two and half hours.

You are in your destination; you will find the himalayas gleaming into red and reddish colour on a evening sun rays. Once after another the reddish colour be shifted to Everest helping Everest Panorama Trekker to scale the Everest is really a tallest one with final rays of the sun on it.

Breakfast, lunch, dinner including overnight stay at Tengboche.

Day 06: Tengboche to Namche (3440m) via Khumjung village (3700m), 6 hours

Wake up early in the morning and before breakfast look at the Everest which will glow with reddish colour boasting itself a tallest one. Including Mt. Everest, all other Lhotse, Nuptse, Amadablam, Island peak, Kantega, Thamserku, Kusum Kangaru on the left line and Twauche Khumbila on the right Kwangde on the back. It is a beautiful moment you experience in the day and taking the breakfast trekkers and will be on its back foot to kyangjuma and from there team will be heading toward Khumjung village.

At Khumjung village trekkers will visit Khumjung school, Khumjung monastery and then an easy way to down to Namche Bazaar.

Overnight at guesthouse, with inclusive of breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 07: Trek to Lukla (2800m), 7 hours

From Namche after taking the breakfast the trekkers will continuously trail down to Lukla which will mostly along with Dudh Koshi river through a lush green valley.

Overnight at guesthouse, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 08: Fly back to Kathmandu

Lukla to Kathmandu is about of 30-minutes amazing scenic fly but becomes a lifetime memory.

Overnight at hotel, breakfast included.

Day 09: Leisure day

A leisure day at Kathmandu today, with making some shopping of the souvenir to the nears and dears.

Overnight at hotel, breakfast included.

Day 10: Farewell

Bravo! Its now done the Everest region trekking with beautiful memory the team will then head to international airport in Kathmandu. A representative of Aaozora Travel & Tour will

assist you to drop there in the airport at 3-hour prior time to your flight schedule. Big bye and waiting you to welcome for the other beautiful destination and trip.

Here are some tips to consider before you arrive:

Notes:

- Adult – Original + photocopy of passport
- Child – Original + photocopy of passport
- Infant – Original + photocopy of passport
- Foreigners or NRI must carry above ID proof with them at the time of booking and carry the same in tour.
- Kathmandu – Pokhara internal flight is included in tour price
- 200, 500 & 2000 Indira Rupee notes are not allowed in Nepal, please carry INR notes of 100/- only
- Be sure to exchange back all the Nepalese currencies before you leave. They are not accepted outside of Nepal. Also taking it out of the country is considered against the law. (if you do wish to take few notes as souvenir, you can purchase them separately)
- Avoid teasing monkeys around the temple and do not display food in front of them, they will snatch it and in the process you may get injured.
- Hotel check in 14:00hrs, check out time is 12:00hrs
- Price could change as per change in government, hotel, airline policy without prior notice.
- Aozora tours & treks will be taking photographs or videos during the trip/ journey to use them for promotion purpose during the program and thereafter. By booking with us, guest agree to allow to use their images to be used for such activity. Guests who prefer their images not being used/shown in promotional activity are asked to convey their preference to the representative at the beginning of their journey.

Tips for trekking

- Visit your general practitioner or travel clinic at least 6-8 weeks before departure to ensure you have all the necessary vaccinations and that they are up to date.

- Appropriate clothing significantly contributes to making your trip comfortable and enjoyable. Essential trekking gear includes:
 - Down jacket
 - Thermals for nights and early mornings
 - Merino wool t-shirt for sunny days
 - Rain jacket for rain and snow
 - Gaiters to prevent snow from entering your boots
 - Waterproof hiking boots
 - Trekking poles for navigating through deep snow
 - Rain covers for your backpack
- Avoid overpacking by taking only the essentials. Pack lightly for your trek, leaving non-essential items at your hotel in Kathmandu.
- Remember to "leave only footprints." Carry a bag for trash and avoid littering the trails.
- Trekking preparation involves building physical fitness through activities like aerobics, strength endurance, and cardio workouts. Aerobic training, such as swimming, running, walking, and jogging, helps your body adjust to lower oxygen levels at higher altitudes.
- Bring your own water bottle to refill from natural sources along the way, rather than purchasing plastic bottles. Teahouses offer water and can boil it for you. Avoid ice cubes or chilled water, as well as alcohol and caffeine, while trekking at high altitudes.
- Respect local customs, especially when visiting monasteries. Do not take photos inside monasteries unless permitted, and always ask for permission before photographing people or children.
- Avoid eating fruits or vegetables unless they have been peeled or cooked.
- On popular trekking trails, you will likely stay in teahouses, which offer basic accommodations like a bed, blanket, and hot food. Do not expect luxury.
- There are no ATMs along the trails in the Himalayas, so calculate how much money you will need and carry it with you. It's better to have a little extra than not enough.

Road transport note:

- All transfers and sightseeing by in A/c vehicle

Visa requirement

- Tourist Visiting Nepal is eligible for The Tourist Visa on Arrival at the Port of Entry (depending on their nationalities).
- The international visitor visiting to Nepal is required to be in possession of a passport and must be valid for a minimum 6 months after the departure date from Nepal and at least 2 empty pages available in the passport for Immigration stamping and visa.

- Tourists holding the passport of Nigeria, Ghana, Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Cameroon, Somalia, Liberia, Ethiopia, Iraq, Afghanistan and Palestine, Syria and Refugees with travel document are not eligible for on arrival visa at the Port of Entry. Tourist of the are to acquire VISA prior to their arrival from their nearby embassies of Nepal government
