There are several other exciting places to visit like a plant nursery with more than a million floras. Most of the meals will be organic that are freshly grown in farmlands. In the meanwhile, you would surely love the wonderful way of exploring the local tradition and culture of Gurungs during evening traditional dancing and singing programs.

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival

Once you land in TIA, a representative from our company will welcome you at the arrival terminal with a nameplate and help you in transferring to hotel for check in. Welcoming refreshments will be provided in the hotel.

Day 02: Kathmandu sightseeing

Our exploration of the Kathmandu Valley will be a guided tour through some of the most significant cultural and historical sites in the region. Our first stop will be the Pashupatinath Temple, situated on the banks of the Bagmati River. This temple holds immense significance for Hindus and is renowned for its intricate architecture, numerous subsidiary temples, and statues. It is also a place where you can observe the unique trident-bearing sadhus, who add to the spiritual ambiance of the site.

Next, we will visit the Swoyambhunath Stupa, commonly known as the Monkey Temple. At the top, we will find a large stupa surrounded by several smaller, whitewashed stupas. The site offers a panoramic view of the Kathmandu Valley, and the area is adorned with vibrant prayer flags, creating a serene and colorful atmosphere. Our journey will then take us to the Boudhanath Stupa, one of the largest stupas in Nepal. Then, we proceed to Boudhanath Stupa, notable for its Buddha eyes and chanting of Buddhist mantras.

After a relaxing lunch break, we explore Kathmandu Durbar Square, a UNESCO World Heritage Site showcasing Newari architecture and Malla period craftsmanship through palaces, courtyards, and temples. Finally, we return to our hotel, having experienced the cultural and historical richness of the Kathmandu Valley.

Day 03: Fly/ drive to Pokhara

We will reach Pokhara after a 4–5-hour drive, arriving in the afternoon. Upon arrival, we will check into our hotel and explore the lakeside area. Pokhara, set on the banks of Phewa Lake, is smaller and more tranquil than Kathmandu, making it an ideal starting point for our trek. Later in the afternoon, you can take a leisurely stroll around the scenic lakeside, enjoying the serene beauty of Phewa Lake and its surroundings.

Day 04: Pokhara sightseeing

Pokhara is a place of natural beauty due to its several lakes, and stunning panoramic view of Himalayans. We will wake up early in the morning and go to Sarangkot viewpoint to capture

blue hour before sunrise. Once the sun rises, we will walk back to hotel for breakfast and on the way back we will visit Bindavasi temple and after breakfast we will check out from hotel and visit Tal Barahi Temple. Davi's fall, Gutpeshow Mahadev's cave, world peace pagoda and visit the market.

Day 05: Drive to Sirubari

After breakfast, we will drive to Sirubari, a journey that combines a short drive and a three-hour walk from Pokhara. Our route takes us through Badkhola and Darau, with a lunch stop at Syangja Bazaar. We aim to arrive at Sirubari village between 4 and 5 pm.

Sirubari is renowned for its delicious local Nepali dishes and the enriching experience of staying with local families, where cultural exchanges are a highlight. The village is one of Nepal's most charming, known for its cleanliness, vibrant colors, and warm atmosphere. The residents are friendly, well-educated, and enthusiastic about tourism, making Sirubari an inviting destination for travelers seeking an authentic Nepali village experience.

Day 06: Early morning walk to Thumro to see Sunrise and mountain views

We will wake up early and head towards Thumro, departing from our homestay on foot to witness the magnificent mountain views. This region boasts abundant flora and fauna, with nearby hills offering splendid vistas of Nepal's western Himalayas. After enjoying the sunrise, we will retrace our steps and return to Sirubari.

Following lunch, we will tour the village, visiting local sites such as the school and the funeral place. In the evening, we will return to our homestay for dinner. We will spend the night in Sirubari, continuing our immersive experience in this welcoming and picturesque village.

Day 07: Sightseeing at Sirubari Village

We have a free day to enjoy various sightseeing activities around the village. The hills above Sirubari offer panoramic views of several majestic peaks, including Mt. Annapurna, Machhapuchare, Manaslu, Dhaulagiri, Nilgiri, Lamjung, and Hiunchuli.

You can immerse yourself in village life by hiking through neighboring villages and observing the daily lifestyles of the local people. One of the highlights of the Sirubari village tour is experiencing the rich Gurung culture. Each night, the community provides entertainment featuring traditional Gurung and Nepali dancing and singing, creating a vibrant cultural experience. Tourists are welcome to join in the cultural program, making for an engaging and memorable evening.

Day 08: Drive to Pokhara

After breakfast, we will retrace our steps, taking the same hiking route back and then driving to the enchanting city of Pokhara. Upon arrival, we will have free time to explore and enjoy the lakeside in the evening, making the most of our last day in this magical city. We will take in the serene beauty and vibrant atmosphere of Phewa Lake and its surroundings. We will stay overnight in Pokhara, cherishing the memories of our journey and the captivating experiences we have had.

Day 09: Fly to Kathmandu

Our journey back to Kathmandu will take approximately 25 minutes by air. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your respective hotel. Later in the evening, you can spend your leisure time exploring the vibrant Thamel area, known for its lively atmosphere, shops, and cafes. We will conclude our adventure with a farewell dinner, celebrating the experiences and memories we have shared. We will stay overnight in Kathmandu, reflecting on the journey and the highlights of our trip.

Day 10: Farewell

As our trip officially comes to an end, you will be escorted to Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA) for your flight home. Please ensure you are ready for transfer at least three hours prior to your flight's departure. We thank you for choosing us and being part of this incredible journey. - Adult – Original + photocopy of passport
- Child – Original + photocopy of passport
- Infant – Original + photocopy of passport
- Foreigners or NRI must carry above ID proof with them at the time of booking and carry the same in tour.
- Kathmandu – Pokhara internal flight is included in tour price
- 200, 500 & 2000 Indira Rupee notes are not allowed in Nepal, please carry INR notes of 100/- only
- Be sure to exchange back all the Nepalese currencies before you leave. They are not accepted outside of Nepal. Also taking it out of the country is considered against the law. (if you do wish to take few notes as souvenir, you can purchase them separately)
- Avoid teasing monkeys around the temple and do not display food in front of them, they will snatch it and in the process you may get injured.

Road transport note:

Visa requirement

- Tourist Visiting Nepal is eligible for The Tourist Visa on Arrival at the Port of Entry (depending on their nationalities).
- The international visitor visiting to Nepal is required to be in possession of a passport and must be valid for a minimum 6 months after the departure date from Nepal and at least 2 empty pages available in the passport for Immigration stamping and visa.
- Tourists holding the passport of Nigeria, Ghana, Zimbabwe, Swaziland, Cameroon, Somalia, Liberia, Ethiopia, Iraq, Afghanistan and Palestine, Syria and Refugees with travel document

are not eligible for on arrival visa at the Port of Entry. Tourist of the are to acquire VISA prior to their arrival from their nearby embassies of Nepal government

3. Changes in the itinerary under Delays of Flight

Most domestic flights to and from Kathmandu are subject to unexpected cancellations due to the unpredictable Himalayan weather conditions in Nepal. Flights directed to Kathmandu from Lukla, Phaplu, or Jupal are particularly prone to cancellations, requiring passengers to wait for a day or even a few days until the weather improves.

If a scheduled flight is canceled at Lukla, Phaplu, or Jupal airports, dinner with night accommodation at a local guesthouse near the airport will be arranged by Aozora Travel and Trekking for the night of the canceled day, and if the cancellation continues therefrom the day all the expenses will be the responsibility of the client itself.

If a flight is bound for a remote area from Kathmandu, Nepalgunj, Pokhara, Dhangadhi, or Bhairahawa, any expenses incurred due to cancellation will be the responsibility of the client. This also applies to flights bound for any of the airports mentioned in the preceding line.
